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WHERE TO EAT

Paella & Local Cuisine

Can Ramonet

Spanish Restaurant - $\in \in$ *Historical family-run restaurant based in Barceloneta. Paella as a religion!*

Restaurant Can Ros

Catalan Restaurant - $\in \in$ Another restaurant of Barceloneta, very close to the beach, we were introduce to this restaurant for a paella by a group of locals. It's extremely good and have a great price/quality ratio.

La Fonda del Port Olimpic

Restaurant - €€ Great view, great food, great paella. A bit touristic though.

<u>Arume</u>

Restaurant - $\in \in$ *High quality restaurant with a fantastic seafood paella in Raval neighbourhood. The area around looks dodgy but it's worth going*

7 Portes

Catalan Restaurant - €€€ Fancy historic and iconic restaurant of Barcelona. More expensive, but offers one of the best seafood paellas of all Barcelona

Can Solé

Catalan Restaurant - $\in \in \in$ In the heart of Barceloneta, a true temple of catalan food; very good paella (20 \in)

Tapas – The Classics

Cerveseria Catalana

Tapas - €€ A classic! One of the best tapas restaurants in town. Be prepared to wait 20 minutes for a table

Ciudad Condal

Tapas - €€ Even more central than Cerveceria Catalana, on the same level quality/price

Quimet & Quimet

Tapas Bar - €€ Old style tapas bar in Poble Sec; very small, you eat standing up. Ideal for an authentic and amazing experience

El Xampanyet

Bar - €€

Comparable to Quimet & Quimet but it is in El Born district, very close to the Picasso Musuem.

El Mercader de l'Eixample

Restaurant - €€ In case Cerveceria Catalana is full (highly probable during weekends) you can try this other tapas restaurant close by.

La Bombeta

Tapas - €€ A true local institution located in Barceloneta. Here you must try the 'Bombas'!

Tapas – Our choices

<u>Cañete</u>

Tapas Bar - $\in \in \in$ Fancy little tapas bar where they cook in front of you. Better to book in advance!

Cal Pep

Tapas - $\in \in \in$ Perhaps the best tapas restaurant in El Born, very close to Santa Maria del Mar

La Alcoba Azul

Tapas Bar - $\in \in$ Extremely small delicious restaurant right in the center of the Gothic Quarter.

Bodega La Palma

Bistrot - $\in \in$ Ideal for a drink as for a full dinner. Great local food and wines.

Bar Centric

Tapas Bar - $\in \in$ Little tapas bar in the North Raval. Very central; simple but elegant.

<u>Blavis</u>

Tapas €€

One of the more intimate tapas restaurants with only 7 tables. Excellent tapas suggested by chef/ wine/dessert and reasonable pricing. Often the owner is present, caring for each and every guest.

Pinchos

Pinchos are small servings of bread with meat/fish/cheese that are placed on little sticks, cheap and delicious!

Carrer de Blai is nicknamed "Pintxos alley" (from Placa Catalunya metro, get green line L3 to Poble Sec metro stop). It is a great place to find lots of cheap and delicious eats.

Our choices: La Tasqueta de Blai Blai 9 Taberna Blai Tonight

<u>Txirimiri</u> Pintxos - € Very good pinchos for 1,50€. Very central position in El Born.

Maitea

Bistrot - $\in \in$ *Restaurant specializing in spanish food and with a huge variety of delicious pinchos.*

Breakfast, Brunch & Cafés

<u>Nomad</u>

Cafeteria - $\in \in$ A true temple devoted to coffee: they have three places in town and they roasted the beans locally.

Departure Coffee

Cafeteria - \in A nicely designed small cafeteria in the North Raval. Very good coffee and few food options.

Pudding

Cafe & pastry shop - $\in \in$ *Quirky interior; great cake and tea selection*

Brunch & Cake Brunch restaurant - €€ Delicious restaurant specialized in brunches (but good also for a lunch) in a very central area of the Eixample district.

<u>Morning Glory</u> Brunch - €€ *Family run small brunch restaurant, hidden in the Raval.*

<u>Caj Chai</u> Teahouse - $\in \in$ *Another adorable teahouse, this one is located in the middle of the Jewish quarter*

Bacoa Burgers - €€ Delicious burgers franchise born in Barcelona.

<u>Goiko</u>

Burgers - €€ Another excellent franchise of burgers recently born in Barcelona.

Sandwiches - € Legendary, massive and cheap sandwiches. What else could you want?

Conesa Entrepans

Sandwiches - € Most favourite sandwiches by the locals. Gluten free and vegan options available

Bar Fidel

Bar - Sandwiches - € Great local spot for sandwiches, in the heart of El Raval.

Kebab

<u>Ugarit</u> Syrian style kebab € Good for take away but also for a dinner. They own several different restaurants all around the city

The Quick Greek

Kebab - € Greek style pita. Delicious and cheap. Many different spots all over the city.

Perejil Kebab - € *Hands down! This is the best kebab in El Raval.*

<u>Maoz</u> Falafel - € A falafel burger chain with an all-you-can-eat toppings option.

La Sureña

Tapas - € Another spanish food chain, fried tapas based. The quantity-price deal is simply ridiculous!

La Fabrica

Empanadas - €

Argentinian Street Food: empanada argentina is a delicious turnover that can be served with a great variety of fillings. This good chain owns several shops in town.

Churros con Chocolate

<u>La Pallaresa</u> Cafeteria - € One of the oldest and most famous traditional churros places in the Gothic Quarter. Try the Crema Catalana too.

<u>Granja Viader</u> Cafeteria - €€ Very traditional and delicious hot chocolate place very near to las Ramblas and the Boqueria Market.

Faborit Casa Amatller

Cafeteria - € Perhaps the best hot chocolate in Barcelona, lcoated inside of a Modernist architecture masterpiece. No churros available

Ice-cream & Horchata

Gelaaati di Marco

Italian style Ice-Cream - €€ Best *gelato* of the Gothic Neighborhood

Oggi Gelato

Italian style Ice-Cream - € A little italian Ice-Cream franchise. Not many options but quality/price great deal.

Gocce di Latte

Italian style Ice-Cream - €€ Avantgarde gelatateria that offers an incredibly originale range of flavors. They also have a vegan gelateria next by.

Paral.lelo Italian style Ice-Cream - € An experimental italian gelateria in Gracia district.

<u>Rocambolesc</u>

Ice-Cream - €€ The gelateria of the "World's Best Pastry Chef" 2014 Jordi Roca i Fontané. It's right on Las Ramblas: not to be missed!

Horchateria Sirvent

Catalan style Ice-Cream - € Historical gelateria of Sant Antoni district. They have all the classics and also a delicious horchata, locals most-favourite sweet drink!

Horchateria El Tio Ché

Cataln style Ice-Cream - € A piece of Barcelona History: the most ancient shop still active in Poble Nou district, famous for its delicious horchata: not to be missed!

Menu del Dia

These special lunchtime menu deals run only during the weekdays, until 4pm.

Starters, Mains, Desert & drink = €15

<u>Cierzo</u>

First Main/Salad, Second Main, Dessert & Drink = €12.50 (Better to book in advance)

Rosa Negra

Mexican; 3 courses & drink = €10.90

<u>Oviso</u>

Menu del Dia for €6.50. Won't find cheaper than that.

Veggie Garden

Vegetarian; 3 courses = \notin 9.25. One of the best value meal deals in the city.

Blau Café

Salad/Starter, Mains (Pasta or Protein), Drink & Coffe = €12. True italian taste

Ciebobcn

Two courses, drink, coffee/dessert = $11,40 \in$ (half menù = $9 \in$) Very decent Catalan and Spanish style cuisine very close to La Pedrera and Casa Battló.

Restaurant - € It's a small and succesfull chain that offer a varied range of vegan food. Don't miss theirs €9.25 *menu del dia*!

Teresa Carles

Tapas Vegetarian Restaurant - €€ The first vegetarian tapas restaurant in Barcelona, a true institution and a temple of vegetarian taste!

Flax and Kale

Healthy Food Restaurant - €€

A Teresa Carles' spin-off ideal for brunches, ideal for pescatarians, vegetarians and vegans.

Indian Restaurant - € All-vegetarian Indian restaurant

A solid vegetarian restaurant with a competitive menu del dia and a varied menu for dinners too.

Pizzeria - Friggitoria € Don't let the name put you off, Italians say this is one of the best pizzerias in the city. Plus: very good napolitan style street food options.

Mexican Bar - $\in \in$ Very popular mexican bar where you can have great traditional food and very good drinks. It's small and usually you have to wait to get a seat.

Tlaxcal Cantina & Taquería Gastronómica

Mexican Restaurant - $\in \in$ *More expensive than the average mexican restaurant but best quality. The Michelada is unforgettable!*

Catalan Restaurant - €€ Standing right by the Santa Caterina's Market, it offers the freshest fish and seafood in the most simple and delicious way

Montolio Can Maño

Restaurant - €€ Fried fish, fried sides, fried waiters and fried walls. Unbeatable prices. Cult!

La Paradeta

Restaurant - $\in \in$ It's a chain of great seafood (displayed like a market stand). The result is very fresh fish for a very good price

Cerverceria El Vaso de Oro

Tapas Bar - $\in \in$ Seafood tapas and great house beer. Informal and chaotic atmosphere = authentic

El pescadito frito

Tapas Bar - € A small family-run restaurant specialized in fried sea-food.

2. Razzmatazz: it contends the throne as most cool club in Barcelona to Apolo. If you are a fun of electronic music you must give it a try. Check its schedule online.

3. Marula: smaller than the previous two, its program can vary widely from Jazz Session to Hip-hop nights to Techno and so on. Check its schedule online

4. Moog: a Barcelona must for techno lovers. Check its schedule online.

5. Macarena: pretty close to Marula and Moog, it's a little room often filled with the perfect vibes for a Barcelona fun night. Check its schedule online

6. Shoko – Opium: right by the Olimpic Harbour you can find these two "Ibiza style" lounge club very popular among tourists
